Start of the Year – Everything went extremely well. Great class sizes. Only concern at the moment is the bees on the playground.

Student Recognition – MCA scores were published in the local newspaper. New tests were developed this year and overall Eagle View was 17% above state average and higher than 5 years ago. Individual MCA scores will be out at the end of October.

- Math 89% proficiency
- Reading 78% proficiency

The Chip Shoppe – Kick-off was September 11, 2013. Money count was on Wednesday, October 2.

Security Update – District is installing buzzers with security cameras connected to each office at each school. Eagle View’s was installed the week of September 23, 2013.
